Two panels 9"x12" to 11"x14"  
Sketchbook or drawing pad for working out composition – 11"x14"  
Pencils HB, H,  
Sharpener  
Kneaded eraser  
Mechanical eraser (optional, but that's my eraser of choice)

Gamsol odorless mineral spirits or oil for washing brushes  
Brush washing jar WITH LID  
At least one cloth rag  
Paper towels for clean up  
Brushes – a variety of sizes, but make sure you have a few small ones for details. I like Jerry's artarama pro-stroke power-cryl with the red tipped handle, rounds and filberts. They are really cheap.  
Palette knife

**PAINT**

White – your choice of white  
Cad yellow light or medium  
Yellow ochre  
Raw umber  
Cad orange  
Alizarin crimson  
Cad red light or medium  
Burnt umber  
Ivory black  
Ultramarine blue  
Any other colors you have around, you're welcome to bring them.

Medium – I like natural pigments oleogel or Gamblin solvent free gel or solvent free medium
