Odorless mineral spirits (and a sealed container to hold them)

Palette (Non absorbent) Sealed wood or glass preferred

5 Surfaces to paint on:

Centurian Oil Primed Linen or Classens DP13 are very good, and affordable options to paint on.

Or any oil (or lead) primed linen canvas or panel. (Try to stay away from gessoboard as it gets slippery) NO COTTON PLEASE

New traditions artist panels. (available from newtraditionsartpanels.com)

- Type C13 Panels on Gatorfoam

Fabriano Artistico – hot press watercolor paper – toned with ink, and sealed with two coats of PVA size.

White artist tape (1")

Palette Knife

Lint free cloth (old t-shirts work best)

Mirror, Black mirror or iPhone

Box cutter

Vine charcoal (generals soft charcoal pencil is ok)

Kneaded eraser
