- -5" x 7," 8" x 10" and/or 9" x 12" primed linen sheets or boards (Centurion or Claessens 13 DP are preferred, but any linen works fine). If you plan on using cotton duck canvas, please add 3-4 coats of any acrylic gesso on top before using it.
- -Sealed wooden palette, neutral gray palette paper or a glass palette.
- -Gamsol/Turpenoid
- -Small jars/containers for solvents/mediums
- -Stainless steel brush washer
- -Paper towels
- -Oleogel from Natural Pigments or Gamblin Solvent Free Gel (Optional)
- -Metal palette knife
- -Synthetic Bristle Short Flats for massing in during the block-in phase, and synthetic bristle and soft rounds in various sizes. Any brand will do, but I recommend any of the following:
 - Trekell Synthetic Hog Bristle Brushes
 - Silver Bristlon Synthetic Brushes (Long handle)
 - Michael Klein Synthetic Pointed Rounds
