## Plein Air Materials List

## Panels

We will be working on a smooth gesso surface. Ampersand Value Series Panels, or Ampersand Gessobord are excellent store bought options. Recommended size 8x10"

## Brushes

Bring a 1 " square or mop brush for washing over a large area, a script liner brush, and a few assorted brushes sizes 1 to 4 . Also, bring any brushes you usually paint with!
Since we are working with a smooth surface, it is important these brushes are soft synthetics! Princeton brand brushes are a good budget option.

## Medium

We will use a fast drying medium for the initial layer, and a "fat" medium for the second pass.
Fast Drying:
A 50/50 mixture of linseed oil and Gamsol. You can also use Venetian Medium by Natural Pigments as an alternative
Fat Medium:
Gamblin Solvent Free Gel (comes in a blue box), or Oleogel by Natural Pigments as an alternative.

## Paper Towels/Cleaning rags

Blue Shop Towels, paper towel, rags or old T-shirts

## Drawing Materials

Sketchpad the same size as your panel, if you are working on an $8 \times 10$ panel bring an $8 \times 10$ pad. Pencil and eraser (mechanical pencils are fine)

## Oil Color Palette

Avoid student grade paints! The basic colors are must haves, the additional colors are nice to have but optional.

## Outdoor Painting Gear

An outdoor painting setup: a pochade box or paintbox with a tripod, and optionally a portable folding chair.
Dress comfortably for outdoor painting! Bring a hat, sunscreen, bugspray, and water.
