

## Angela Cunningham Portrait Block-in Painting Supply List

- Canvas:** size range from 9" x 12" to 12" x 16". Recommend a linen portrait weave (smooth) either oil or acrylic primed. claessens 13, or ArtFix (my favorite). Canvas panels are great to practice on. Or even just loose sheets of canvas pinned or taped to a board. self made panels can also be used in place of canvas.
