

## **Portrait Drawing for Teens: Exploring Mediums with Tori Cole**

### Materials List:

A variety of 9x12 inch or 8x10 inch sheets of the papers listed below are recommended for the portrait sketch drawings for the first two days, and one sheet of 18x24 inch paper (either toned or white based on student's preference) is recommended for the final portrait drawing for last three days.

- Strathmore series 400 drawing paper
- Mi Tientes canson paper (recommended colors: cream, felt grey, ivory)
- Pencils 2H, H, HB, 2B
- White chalk pencil
- Kneaded eraser
- Pencil eraser (mono zero is a great brand)
- Red chalk pencil (conte brand or any pastel pencil will work, I've also used the Albrecht Durer watercolor pencil as a drawing pencil and it's worked well)
- Sandpaper block
- X-acto knife
- 18x24 inch drawing board
