

# **Summer Classical Art Intensive for Teens**

## **MATERIALS LIST**

### **Drawing**

- ☐ Staedtler Pencils 2H, H, HB, 2B
- ☐ Sandpaper block for sharpening pencils
- ☐ Utility Knife or X-acto knife
- ☐ Cooking Metal Skewer or thin knitting needle for measuring. This must be straight.
- ☐ Kneaded Eraser
- ☐ Tombow Mono Zero Mechanical Eraser Round, 2.3 mm
- ☐ Synthetic soft bristle brush, size 2 or 4.
- ☐ Synthetic Flat brush size 2 or 4
- ☐ Masking or Artist Tape
- ☐ Strathmore Series 400 Drawing Pad. Any size between 9"x12" and 18"x24"
- ☐ Drawing board the same size or larger than your drawing pad

### **Painting**

- ☐ A "sealed" or "finished" wooden palette
- ☐ Stainless steel palette cups (clips onto palette)
- ☐ Gamsol small
- ☐ Linseed oil small
- ☐ Metal palette knife. I prefer ones that are slim and flexible, but any will do.
- ☐ Brush cleaning soap. I use Zote laundry bar soap and cleaning gloves to protect my hands.  
Any brand of brush cleaning soap will also do
- ☐ Paper Towels
- ☐ Small Leakproof jar OR portable brush washer
- ☐ Canvas Pad or Canvas Panels  
Centurion OP DLX panels 5x7 (optional 5 pcs), 6x8 (7-10 pcs), 8x10 panels (5-7 pcs)  
You can also purchase a Centurion OP DLX pad 11x14 instead of the panels

☐ Oil Paint

An affordable option that I recommend is the Winton Oil Paint Basic Set of 10.

Student grade paints are perfectly fine. Please make sure to have:

☐ Brushes

A variety is good. Cheap brands are fine. Try to have at least:

- 2-3 Small soft rounds with pointed tips (watercolor brushes works great)
- 2 bristle round brushes
- 2 bristle filbert brushes
- One flat medium sized (2-4 in) bristle or china bristle
- One soft synthetic fan brush (optional)

☐ Plein Air Equipment

Plein air set-ups vary from artist to artist. Ideally, you want something lightweight and portable that fits in a bag or backpack. Start with affordable materials and observe what other artists use before investing in a lot of gear.

**Option 1. Aluminum or Wood Travel Easel**

Brands: Creative Mark, SoHo, Blick, Richeson, Mabef, etc.

**Option 2. Pochade Box + a Camera Tripod**

To use a pochade box, you will also need a lightweight camera tripod. These come with quick-clip attachment to attach to the bottom of the pochade box.

Brands:

-Sienna Plein Air Pochade Box or The New Wave u.go Plein-air

-SIRUI Carbon Fiber Travel Tripod, 55.1"

-SIRUI Camera Tripod & Monopod Stand, 78.7" Tall Aluminum Tripod

Other:

-Hat with brim

-Clothing layers (seasonal considerations--a light jacket and a raincoat are a good idea) and lightweight long sleeves for summertime)

-Sunscreen
