

## Teen Drawing & Painting Workshop Materials

### **Drawing Materials**

- Drawing board or a rigid support along with masking tape or clips to secure your drawing pad or paper.
- 18 x 24" Strathmore 400 Series (or something similar) This is a medium smooth paper. Really smooth paper is not recommended.
- Pencils –2B, B, HB, H, 2H, graphite pencils (or Mechanical pencil)- X-acto knife & sandpaper strip for sharpening the pencils
- Gray Kneaded eraser and Tombow MONO Zero Refillable eraser.
- Measuring tool such as one long skinny knitting needle or bbq skewer or bicycle spoke. Something long, skinny and straight.
- Small Hand mirror

Some brand of pencils I recommend:

- Mitsu-Bishi - Hi Uni Wooden Pencils HB-H-2B
- STAEDTLER Mars Lumograph
- Tombow Mono

### **Painting Materials**

- 3 8X10 or 10x12 or 11x14 primed Linen (not cotton or paper for painting, please) I recommend buying Centurion linen pads on amazon or Jerry's artarrama. You can then tape the loose piece of linen on a board. You can also buy 3 primed linen boards instead.
- Small bottle of Cold pressed Linseed Oil
- Small Bottle of Mineral Spirits (Gamsol or Turpentine)
- Small empty container to mix the medium in
- Two little aluminium or plastic palette clip containers
- One small rag and or paper towels
- Small Wooden Pallette
- Palette Knife

- Oil colors: titanium white, yellow ochre, cadmium red light, ivory black, raw umber. Extra colors optional: alizarin crimson, ultramarine blue, Naples yellow, chrome oxide green from Gamblin.
- Oil brand suggestions: Gamblin, Windsor and Newton, Michael Hardin, Old Holland. Raw umber from W&N, Gamblin or Old Holland, not from MH.
- Brushes: A selection of Round synthetic brushes going from #2 to #8. One or two filbert synthetic #4 or #6 or similar And a just a few Filbert bristles.

Suggestion on brand for brushes: See of these brushes might be expensive but they last years. Rosemary Brushes for the Filbert Synthetic. Robert Simmons for the Filbert Bristles and Blick or Davinci or Rosemary for Synthetic brushes. The store of The Art Students League of NY sells good brushes as well as Blick Stores. Online might take a while to arrive if you are ordering Rosemary Brushes.
